



Honkandambo Traveller's Palm

Ravenala 'Honkandambo'

Description:

A striking, compact linear palm with red striped leaf petioles in a symmetrical display; large, feathery green leaves crown the plant in a perfect semi-circle; makes a spectacular landscape screen or accent

Planting & Growing

Honkandambo Traveller's Palm will grow to be about 10 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 10 feet. It has a low canopy with a typical clearance of 4 feet from the ground, and is suitable for planting under power lines. It grows at a slow rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for 50 years or more.

This tropical plant should only be grown in full sunlight. It does best in average to evenly moist conditions, but will not tolerate standing water. This plant should not require much in the way of fertilizing once established, although it may appreciate a shot of general-purpose fertilizer from time to time early in the growing season. It is not particular as to soil type or pH. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. This particular variety is an interspecific hybrid.; however, as a cultivated variety, be aware that it may be subject to certain restrictions or prohibitions on propagation.
